Purpose: To establish 25 multipurpose facilities in rural Cambodia.

Places: To be determined by the Kingdom of Cambodia Ministry of Education

People: The combination of nationals and expatriates to form multinational teams.

Plan: South East Asia Prayer Center will build on land donated by the Kingdom of Cambodia and titled to Word of Life Church educational facilities to include one building with cement floor, one meter of block, wooden sides and corrugated roof measuring 150 ft by 50 ft. A second building of 2 stories constructed of cement and steel with a tile roof measuring not less than 150 ft. x 50ft. will also be constructed. There will be drilled a fresh water well inclusive of submersible pump, elevated water tank, and sufficient piping to deliver water to a toilet, bathhouse, and kitchen facilities. The power supply for this facility will be “Solar Collection” storage and distribution to provide fans and complete electrical service for all buildings. Water treatment will meet current ISO standards.

Facility Use: Shall be determined by mutual agreement of all parties. And shall include: preschool, elementary, and secondary education between the hours of 8AM and 4PM following the national school schedule.

Vocational training for older youth shall begin at 5PM with courses offered including building trades, civil engineering, computer science, English, Chinese and what ever courses are determined necessary by the agreement of all parties.

Orphans shall be received, housed and given equal opportunity to education at the facility. They shall be overseen by New Hope for Orphans.

Christian worship services shall be held weekly at the facility.

Boys Brigade and Girls Brigade Training shall be made available to all students of an appropriate age.

Manpower: The South East Asia Prayer Center will assist the Ministry of Education in the development of curriculum and shall provide one project coordinator, one preschool director, one elementary education director, one secondary education director, one educational services director, one orphanage director and necessary staff, one vocational trainer, and one Pastor/Counselor.

The Kingdom of Cambodia shall provide workers to serve as trainees as each building is built so that they will learn the trades involved in such construction and can become mobile construction teams equipped for the rebuilding of rural Cambodia and the establishment of educational facilities for every region.

Duration of Agreement: This agreement is initially for a five (5) year period beginning from 15 June 2004 and extending through 14 June, 2009. Any party of the agreement can call for a review at any time. There will be an annual review from 15 April to 15 May of each year of the agreement. At that time modifications can be suggested, but must be affirmed by all parties for changes to be made.

If, during the time of the agreement there is forced a cessation of labor due to climate or political concerns, the days lost will be added to the end date of the agreement.

Investment Amounts and Accounting: The South East Asia Prayer Center will establish an office and accounts in Phnom Penh. Monies donated to the project will be disbursed against purchase orders and receipted daily. All funds will be accounted for.

Educational grants and orphan support will be directed to New Hope for Orphans and will be distributed according to guidelines agreed upon by all parties. N orphan shall be offered for adoption outside the Kingdom of Cambodia as we are building the future of the Kingdom.

The Accounting of the project shall be open for review by all parties to the agreement. The books will be kept at the South East Asia Prayer Center office and in the possession of the Project Coordinator.

The Kingdom of Cambodia shall provide necessary tariff relief for all equipments necessary for the project. And shall expedite land transfer and registration.

The teachers at each facility shall be paid by the combination of a grant from the South East Asia Prayer Center and the Kingdom of Cambodia.

Staff provided by the South East Asia Prayer Center, New Hope for Orphans and Word of Life Church shall be paid by their sponsoring entity and shall not become a burden to the Kingdom of Cambodia. Any health need, relocation cost, or damages incurred by these staff shall be the responsibility of their sponsoring entity.
